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About the exam

The first examination is tomorrow, Thursday, June 9.

The exam covers everything on the syllabus to date.

There are 10 questions on the exam.

The types of questions include *calculation*, *application*, and *interpretation*.

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Examples of calculation

Calculation with vectors: length, dot product, cross product, projection.

Calculation with matrices: sums and products, reduced matrices, inverse matrices, determinants, solving a system of equations.

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Examples of application

With vectors: angles, work, area of a parallelogram (or of a triangle), volume of a parallelepiped, equations of lines and planes, intersections of lines and planes.

With matrices: writing a vector as a linear combination of other vectors, testing linear independence of vectors, solving a system by Cramer's rule.

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Examples of interpretation

Is a certain set a vector space? Is a certain subset a subspace?

Is a certain function linear? one-to-one? invertible?

Does a system of equations have a unique solution? infinitely many solutions? no solutions?

What does a certain linear transformation represent geometrically?
